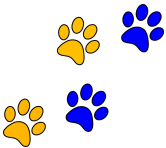




Hazelwood Announcements for Friday, September 17, 2021



Guidance for when your child is sick:

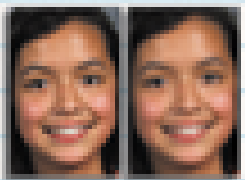

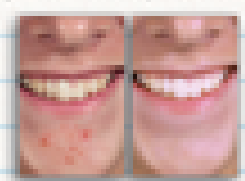

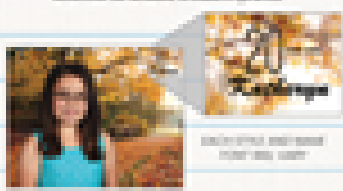
