- ★ Starting Monday, February 28th, we will be returning to our morning routine that we had before the Pandemic. All 7th & 8th graders may get their breakfast at the Kiosk by the gym and then **MUST** report to the gym before school starts. All 5th & 6th graders may get their breakfast from the cafeteria and will eat in the cafeteria. All 5th & 6th graders **MUST** report to the Auditorium before school starts. This will help us ensure safety and order in the building before school starts.
- ★ Starting Friday, March 3rd, all students will be required to use their lockers or cubbies. We will take Monday-Thursday or next week to help students find and get into their lockers. Bookbags and purses **MUST** remain in lockers or cubbies starting Friday. These are causing tripping hazards in the classrooms.
- ★ Hats and hoods are not allowed in the building. Once you enter the building, please remove your hats and hoods. Thank you!
- ★ Masks are now optional in our buildings, but they are still mandatory on the bus. Please be sure you have a mask when you leave school so you're ready to go on the bus.
- ★ Period Zero students will not attend NAHS on March 2nd due to the SAT.
- ★ There is a girls 5th - 8th grade church invitational on the ledge outside the office for any young ladies interested.
- ★ High school is right around the corner! As a middle schooler, college might seem a long way off, but there are still things you can do to prepare for this important time in your life right now. You can enroll as a 21st Century Scholar from the time you enter 7th grade to June 30th of your 8th grade year, and if you keep your grades up and meet a few

eligibility requirements, you may be eligible to earn up to a full tuition scholarship to an Indiana College or University.

 - Parent or guardian's Social Security Number
 - Previous year gross income amounts for all members of the household (Example: if you are applying after December 31, 2020, use 2020 amounts).


