You can enroll as a 21st Century Scholar from the time you enter 7th grade to June 30th of your 8th grade year, and if you keep your grades up and meet a few eligibility requirements, you may be eligible to earn up to a **full tuition scholarship to an Indiana College or University.**
 - **NAHS is hosting a 21st Century Scholar workshop for parents of 7th and 8th grade students on February 24th from 4-6PM in the NAHS media center.** Parents are encouraged to attend to get assistance with creating your scholar track account and submitting the application.  - The application process doesn't take long, but you will need the following information to complete:
 - Student Social Security Number, DOB, address
 - Parent or guardian's Social Security Number
 - Previous year gross income amounts for all members of the household (Example: if you are applying after December 31, 2020, use 2020 amounts).

★ Update:

- Contact Tracing Protocols
 - Now that masks are required of everyone in the building, the “3 feet rule” is in play. We are required to contact those students within 6 feet of a positive person for at least 15 minutes. Unvaccinated individuals determined to be close contacts by that guideline will need to quarantine. Vaccinated individuals determined to be close contacts by that guideline will be required to wear a mask for 14 days.

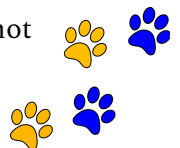
The following 4 items will not follow the color coding policy:

- All unvaccinated adults (employees and visitors) must wear facial coverings while in our facilities.
- Due to federal regulations for public transportation, face coverings are required on school buses for all students and staff. This policy will continue until the Feds change it. This policy is independent from the other color coded policies.
- Indoor athletic and spectator events and sales will be governed by the IHSAA and other guidance factors.
- At present, there are no mask requirements for outdoor activities regardless of color code.

NEW ALBANY FLOYD COUNTY COLOR CODE COVID POLICY	
Advisory Level	
BLUE	Students who are not fully vaccinated are <u>recommended</u> to wear a face covering; however, it will be optional during the school day. Visitors, field trips and events allowed.
YELLOW	Students who are not fully vaccinated are <u>strongly recommended/encouraged</u> to wear face coverings; however it will be optional during the school day. Visitors, field trips and events allowed.
ORANGE	Face coverings will be <u>required</u> for all staff and students on school buses and indoors, unless a medical situation dictates otherwise. No field trips. Indoor event have capacity and safety requirements.
RED	Face coverings are <u>required</u> for all staff and students on school buses and indoors, unless a medical situation warrants otherwise. Visitors will not be permitted beyond the main office area.

Guidance for when your child is sick:

- If your child has a fever, vomiting or diarrhea, please keep him/her home until he/she is symptom free for 24 hrs. Please call the Attendance Hotline at 812-542-3301 to report your child's absence.
- If your child was a close contact to someone that tested positive for Covid and was not wearing a mask at the time of the exposure, please call our Nurse, Ms. Fisher, at 812-542-8502 for guidance.
- If your child has Covid symptoms and you are going to get him/her tested for Covid, please do not send him/her to school and call our Nurse, Ms. Fisher, at 812-542-8502 to report this.
- If your child has tested positive for Covid, please call Dr. Waters at 812-542-8502 as soon as you are able to do so to report this.
